As the owner of a franchise who was scammed by Franchise FastLane, I strongly support the proposed Model Franchise Broker Registration Act. My experience with Premier Martial Arts, brokered by Franchise FastLane, highlights the need for this regulation. I was misled by unauthorized earnings claims and pressured into a franchise that wasn't a good fit. The registration, disclosure, and recordkeeping requirements in the Act are essential to protect prospective franchisees from similar deceptive practices.

Hundreds of people purchased the same exact franchise I did and lost their life savings as well. Something should be done and we don't know where to turn.
